TRAINING AND STUDENT FINANCIAL SERVICES

Skookum Jim™ Friendship Centre's *Training and Student Financial Services (TSFS)* is a program that is dedicated to assisting urban Aboriginal people with furthering their pre-employment training and education. The program grants AHRDA Training Program funding and NWT Post Secondary funding.

AHRDA:

AHRDA provides students with tuition, books and living allowance.

Target Group:

Urban Aboriginal people that are not a member of a Yukon First Nation (YFN).

What programs can be funded?

- ☛ Trades
- ☛ Training Programs

NWT POST SECONDARY EDUCATION:

The *NWT Post Secondary fund* supports registered NWT First Nations, Inuit and Inuvialuit in their pursuit of post secondary education. The fund provides students with books, tuition and a living allowance.



Target Group:

All registered NWT First Nations, Inuit and Inuvialuit with a minimum of one year residency in Yukon.

What programs can be funded?

Full time studies (3 or more courses per semester) in:

- ☛ College Preparation
- ☛ Community College Diploma or Certificate Programs
- ☛ Bachelor/Undergraduate Programs
- ☛ Professional/Graduate Programs
